The aim of the workshop was to increase awareness of the EU-SEC Project, with focus on the gamechanging development of the Multiparty Recognition Framework.

Lively discussions took place on the state of cloud compliance in Europe, cyber security threats and especially the need for a framework which supports the idea of assessing which existing cloud compliance scheme has equivalent requirements to be certified (such as BSI C5, CSA STAR, ISO27001, SOC 2).

Cloud Security Alliance Publishes Enhancement to Cloud Control Matrix

The Cloud Security Alliance (CSA) is a member of the EU-SEC project and contributes its comprehensive knowledge of cloud computing and certification.

The **Cloud Controls Matrix** (CCM) is a baseline set of security controls created by the Cloud Security Alliance to help enterprises assess the risk associated with a cloud computing provider.

The recently published C5 Addendum contains additional controls that serve to bridge the gap between CCM and the German Federal Office for Information Security (BSI) Compliance Controls Catalogue (C5).

The work on C5 addendum was largely done in the context of the EU-SEC project,


